

## 6 Days 4 Nights Kyushu, Japan

### Day 1 SINGAPORE– KYUSHU (FUKUOKA)

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport, depart for your flight to Kyushu (Fukuoka), Japan.

### Day 2 FUKUOKA - OBAMA LUNCH / DINNER

Upon arrival, meet and greet by our English speaking guide. Transfer to Nagasaki. Visit **Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine**. Tenmangu Shrines are dedicated to the spirit of Sugawara Michizane, a scholar and politician of the Heian Period. Because of his great learning, Michizane has been associated with Tenjin, a Shinto deity of education and is popular among students. Stop by **Ureshino Ocha (Green Tea) Village** to learn more on the production of Japanese Green Tea in this factory. Next, visit **Nagasaki Peace Park** which commemorates the atomic explosion on 9 August 1945. Within the park, you will find Peace Statue and Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum, the latter housing preserved evidence of the atomic blast. Check in to Onsen hotel, have dinner within hotel. After dinner, enjoy **Japan's longest public foot spa** nearby hotel.



### Day 3 OBAMA - MATSUSHIMA BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER

After breakfast, visit **Unzen Jigoku**, an attraction of high-temperature hot springs and gasses erupt violently from everywhere, and with the strong smell of sulfur, the steamy scenery evokes a vision of hell. There are around 30 geothermal fields, such as “Oito Jigoku”, and “Daikyokan Jigoku”. Next, visit **Unzen Volcano Disaster Center**. Visit **Shimabara Castle** which is reputed for an unusually striking castle reconstruction due to its regular, tall yet almost pyramidal design and **Samurai House**. Next, proceed to Kuninotsu Port for a **wild dolphin watch cruise** (subjects to weather conditions)



**Day 4 MATSUSHIMA - BEPPU  
BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER**

After breakfast, visit **Kumamoto Castle** (Photo stop outside view). Next, visit **Sakura-no-baba Josaien**. In the Edo Period (1603-1868), a bustling town sprawled at the foot of Kumamoto's formidable castle. Today, that town looks quite a bit different, but you can still find a taste of the old days at Sakura-no-baba Josaien, an Edo-themed complex just down the hill from Kumamoto Castle. Next, visit a **fruit farm** for some seasonal fruit picking. Transfer to Mt Aso and ascend to **Mt Aso observatory**, world's largest volcano crater. Mt Aso comprises 5 peaks including 1 active volcano.

**Day 5 BEPPU - FUKUOKA  
BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER**

After breakfast, make a stop at **Kitsuki Castle Town** to visit rustic samurai houses. Next, experience a **kimono dress up** session. Next, visit **Tosu Outlet Mall** for some free time shopping. Tonight, enjoy **company dinner** at a special venue (*course meal includes a chance to fish on your own and kitchen will cook for you plus free flow drinks & basic alcohol*)
