Day 1 Kuala Lumpur – Sydney/Melbourne – Hobart (Meals On Board)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur Airport for your flight to **Hobart** via Sydney/Melbourne.

Day 2 Hobart (Meals On Board/Lunch/Dinner)

Upon arrival, prepare your tummy for a procession of tasty treats, beginning with a visit to **Barilla Bay Oyster Farm** where you can learn more about the fascinating production process of oysters. After that, ascend the summit of **Mt Wellington** for unsurpassed panoramic views of Hobart and its surroundings on a clear day or embark on a brief city tour.

Day 3 Hobart (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, begin your day with a visit at **Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary** where you will get a chance to come face to face with animals that went extinct long ago. Meet the famous Tasmanian Devil and other native wildlife. Next, head to **Curringa Farm** where you will go on a farm tour that includes working dog and sheep shearing show.

Day 4 Hobart (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to **Freycinet National Park** which consists of knuckles of granite mountains all but surrounded by azure bays and white sand beaches, protects a superb array of plants and animals. The park is best known for the stunning beauty of **Wineglass Bay** - its crystal-clear waters and curvaceous white beach is one of Tasmania's most celebrated views.

Day 5 Hobart – Launceston (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, visit **Ashgrove Cheese Dairy Door** to view the production of this well-loved dairy product and savour different types of cheese including the delectable chilli cheese. Photostop at **Sheffield Town**, the once-dying town and now has reinvented itself as a village of painted wonders. After that, proceed to **Cradle Mountain–Lake St Clair National Park**. Cradle Mountain is synonymous with nature, wilderness and all things pristine. Wildlife is in abundance in this spectacular national park, giving opportunity to encounter Tasmanian devils, quolls, platypus, echidna, wombats and the highly inquisitive black currawong.

Day 6 Launceston (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, visit the tranquil **Cataract Gorge Reserve**, a beautiful natural amphitheatre located in the heart of Launceston where you get to experience the 308-metre-long chairlift ride (one way). Later, proceed to **Grindelwald Swiss Village**. The village of Grindelwald was established in the 1980s as a unique residential development. All houses in Grindelwald have been built in Swiss style, with wide eaves, flower boxes, window shutters and balconies. The settlement is fringed with glassy lakes and views of the Tamar Valley.

Day 7 Launceston – Melbourne/Sydney – Kuala Lumpur (Breakfast/Meals On Board)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home.
