# 6D5N Captivating Taiwan (LTW6CT)

#### DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR - TAOYUAN (Meals on Board/-)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to **Taoyuan**. Upon arrival, we will head to **Taoyuan Night Market** to taste a variety of mouthwatering street foods, followed by check-in at a hotel in Taoyuan for rest. **Hotel: Century Hotel Taoyuan or similar** 

#### DAY 2 TAOYUAN - MIAOLI

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to **Miaoli** and experience the century-old railway journey, aboard the **Old Mountain Line Rail Bike**. It is the most beautiful mountain railway in Taiwan, connecting nine tunnel groups and four consecutive bridges. When taking the rail bike, you will encounter scenic spots such as damaged in disastrous earthquakes and its broken arches remain is now known as **Remains of Longteng Bridge**. Shengxing Train Station is a century-old station and the highest-altitude station in the Western Taiwan Railway Line. There are many facilities from the Japanese colonial period in the station, becoming valuable artifacts of this historical site. Later visit West Lake Resortopia, an attraction that combines leisure, entertainment, cultural experiences, and natural beauty - an ideal place to relax and enjoy nature. Here, you can experience the fun of visiting the Gardens of Versailles on the train and admire the meticulously manicured plants and flowers, or enjoy live performances, explore the colorful butterfly zone, and much more.

Hotel: West Lake Resortopia or similar

Note: Old Mountain Line Rail Bike is not suitable for pregnant women and child below 3 years old. For passenger with high blood pressure, heart disease, or other mobility issues, kindly evaluate your own physical and mental condition before taking the ride.

#### DAY 3 MIAOLI - YILAN

#### (Breakfast/Lunch/-)

After breakfast, head to Yilan, known as the "Taipei's Backyard Garden". Visit **Yilan Animal Kingdom**, home to Taiwan's first open interactive Australian kangaroo experience area. Here, you can interact closely and feed kangaroos, as well as explore various other animal habitats, such as goats, capybaras, alpacas, and llamas. You can also experience wearing traditional kimonos or participate in DIY plant crafts at your own expense. This evening, savour mouth-watering delicacies of different cuisines at the lively **Luodong Night Market** at your own expense. Tonight, check in to a hot spring resort, where you can rejuvenate yourself in your in-room hot spring tub.

#### Hotel: Just Sleep Yilan Jiaoxi Hotel or similar

Note: Please bring along your swim cap and swimwear if you wish to use the public hot spring in the resort. Public bath is available in some hotels.

#### DAY 4 YILAN - TAIPEI

#### (Breakfast/Lunch/-)

This morning, head to Taiwan's cultural, economic, and political centre, Taipei. First, proceed to **National Martyrs' Shrine**, built to honour the fallen Kuomintang soldiers after the Chinese Civil War. If time permits, you can watch the Changing of the Guard ceremony! After, get captivated by the charming garden landscape at **Chiang Kai-shek Shilin Residence Park**. Enjoy exploring the Chinese-style inner garden landscaped with a stream running under an artificial bridge, peculiarly

shaped rocks, and a red-painted Chinese summerhouse, whereas the European-style outer garden with carpet bed of exuberant flowers. Then proceed to **Dihua Street**, lined with beautifully restored shop houses occupied by long-established businesses and recently opened cultural-creative enterprises. Wander through the alleys and streets of the old **Dadaocheng** area, where you will be presented with a rich mix of East and
