DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR – INCHEON

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Incheon

DAY 2 INCHEON – BUSAN (Meals on Board / Lunch /Dinner)

Upon arrival at Incheon airport, you will be welcomed by our friendly tour guide and driver before transferred to **Busan**, heading to the colourful Busan **Gamcheon Culture Village**, also known as Korea's Santorini. There are also many of the buildings in the village that are painted a stark white to contrast rather beautifully like the pictures you see of Santorini in Greece. Then we will arrive the **Oryukdo Observation Deck + Skywalk**. You can walk on the glass floor, which will give you an exciting and exciting experience, and you can also watch the unique scenery of the mainland coastal areas. Then we will pass by **Gwangan Bridge** Then we will arrive **GUKJE Market** to enjoy shopping Dinner and overnight in Busan Hotel.

DAY 3 BUSAN (Breakfast/ Lunch /Dinner)

After breakfast, go to Busan famous **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple**, which is the only temple in Korea built by the sea. It is surrounded by mountains and seas, and its surrounding scenery is beautiful. There are landscapes in the Dragon Temple, such as the Guanyin Temple, the Daxiong Hall, the Dragon King Hall, the Cave Method Hall and the Four Lions Three-story Stone Pagoda, among which the most famous scenery is the 108th Stage and Sunrise Rock. Standing on the rock, you can clearly hear the sound of waves lapping on the rock wall and enjoy the spectacular beauty of sunrise. After that, we will go to **Songdo Yonggung Suspension Bridge**, which is located in Pine Forest Park on the east side of Songdao Bathing Beach, connecting with Turtle Island. Today, this bridge is located in Yannan Park, and it is reborn as a modern version of "Songdao Longgong Suspension Bridge" connecting the East Island. On the Songdao Dragon Palace Suspension Bridge, which is 127 meters long and Escape Room: Tournament of Champions meters wide, you can not only experience the excitement of walking on the sea, but also enjoy the pleasant seascape and the heavenly beauty presented by the cliff. After lunch, we will go to the unique **Jangrim Port Bunezia** which was originally a small dock for fishing boats to park. However, after renovation and renovation a

few years ago, it became a colorful fishing port. Because it has the feeling of the colorful island of Bruano in Venice, Blano, Italy, it is also called the "Funis" scenic spot. The surrounding area is also relatively quiet and exotic. Then we will go to the busiest **Jagalchi Market** in Busan, which is the largest seafood market in Busan. When you come to Jagalchi Market, you can experience the selling skills of Azhu Ma, the art of arranging fish in the market, and you can also eat fresh seafood such as raw octopus and king crab. DAY 4 BUSAN – GYENGJU (Breakfast/ Lunch /Dinner)

Today, soak up some Korean history and culture at **Gyeongju**, ancient capital of the Silla dynasty for more than 1,000 years and also known as the museum without walls. First of all, we will visit **Cheomsandae+Dareungwon**, the oldest historical and civilized scenic spot in South Korea. In Silla era, the kings determined the farming period by observing the weather at the observatory, and there is also a legend that the observatory was used to predict the good or bad luck of the country. After lunch, go to **Lake Bomun**, which is located in the center of Gyeongju, near the famous **Bulgoksa Temple**, a world cultural heritage. Later when to the **Donggung Palace**, also known as "Wild Duck Pool", was built during the Silla Dynasty, and it was also the shooting location of the famous Korean drama "Palace"! When Silla perished, the ruined place was named Yanyachi after the poems of Korean poets. It was not until the pottery fragments with the inscription "Moon Pool" were unearthed in 80 yuan that it was renamed " Donggung Palace".
