Then, join the <b>farm tour</b>, in which you will get to ride a tractor, hand-feed and take photos with many of the friendly animals including romney sheep, cattle, deer, llamas, ostriches, pigs and alpacas. Experience the majestic and magical <b>Redwoods Treewalk</b>, suspended high above the forest floor. Encounter 75-metre-tall redwoods as you walk across eco-suspended bridges and platforms regarded by many as one of the best treetop walks in New Zealand. Head to <b>Te Puia</b> to view the natural wonderland of bubbling mud pools, erupting geysers and steaming hot springs at <b>Whakarewarewa – The Living Maori Village</b>. Next, learn about Maori culture at <b>New Zealand Maori Arts &amp; Crafts Institute</b>. To top off this evening’s experience, enjoy a traditionally cooked hangi <b>feast dinner</b> from earthen ovens and relish in a <b>Maori concert</b> with lively songs and performances.</p> <p><b>DAY 5 ROTORUA – AUCKLAND – CHRISTCHURCH – KAIKOURA (Breakfast/Western Dinner With Lobster)</b>          Transfer to Auckland airport for your domestic flight to <b>Christchurch</b>. Upon arrival, embark on a city tour of Christchurch and drive past <b>Transitional “Cardboard” Cathedral</b>, <b>Arts Centre</b> and <b>Hagley Park</b>. ### DAY 6 KAIKOURA (Breakfast/Dinner)

Today, hop onto a **whale watching cruise** in Kaikoura to see these majestic and colossal sperm whales – the largest toothed whales in the world! Spend the rest of the day at leisure. You may join an optional tour swimming with the dolphins or watching the fascinating creatures from the comfort of a boat or go for a quad bike tour at your own expense. If weather permits, take a helicopter ride to a scenic flight above the Kaikoura Peninsula and up to the mountain ranges for a landing, at your own expense.

### DAY 7 KAIKOURA – CHRISTCHURCH (Breakfast/Chinese Dinner)
