DAY 2 PRAGUE

(Meals on Board/Pork Knuckle Dinner)

Welcome to Prague, the capital and administrative, cultural, business and industrial centre of Czech Republic. Next, stroll around the **Old Town Square**, a lively center featuring stunning Gothic architecture such as the **Church of Our Lady Before Tyn**. Don't forget the must-see **Astronomical Clock**, where a crowd gathers every hour to witness the procession of the Apostles and other allegorical figures. DAY 3 PRAGUE - ČESKÝ KRUMLOV

After breakfast, transfer to the charming town of Český Krumlov with a walking orientation of the **Old Town**. Take in the historic atmosphere, wander the cobblestone streets, and admire the colorful facades. Visit the **Český Krumlov Castle** for stunning architecture and rich history and the beautifully preserved interiors and exhibitions. Continue your tour to the **Cloak Bridge**, an impressive multi-level bridge that connects different parts of the castle. You can also stroll through the **Castle Garden**, a serene and beautifully landscaped area perfect for a leisurely walk. Then, continue the tour to the main square - **Svornosti Square**, which is surrounded by beautiful historic buildings and offers a glimpse into the town's vibrant past.

DAY 4 ČESKÝ KRUMLOV - BERCHTESGADEN - SALZBURG (Breakfast/Chinese Dinner)

This morning, depart Český Krumlov and travel to Berchtesgaden, a picturesque town in Germany known for its stunning alpine scenery and historical sites. Embark on an underground adventure at the **Salt Mine Salzbergwerk Berchtesgaden**. Learn about the history and process of salt mining, take a ride on the mine train, slide down the wooden slides, and marvel at the underground Mirror Lake. Your next destination will be Salzburg, the hometown of Mozart and where well-loved musical, "The Sound of Music", was based on. Discover this delightful musical city at your leisure and rejoice in sights like **Mirabell Gardens** and Salzburg **Cathedral**, **St. Peter's Abbey**, **Mozart's Birthplace** and **Residenzplatz**.

This picturesque lakeside town, nestled on the southwestern banks of the Hallstatter Lake, has a rich history of salt mining dating back to its early days. Capture the beauty of Hallstatt with a photo stop at the 1785-built **Evangelical Church** located in the town center. Proceed to the beautiful city of Vienna otherwise known as Wien.

DAY 6 VIENNA - PARNDOF DESIGNER OUTLET - BRATISLAVA (Breakfast/Chinese Dinner) Start your day with the city tour to view significant landmarks from Ringstrasse to Opera House, Hofburg Palace, Rathausplatz, Parliament Building, Stadtpark and Burgtheater. The first stop of the tour is the renowned **Matthias Church**, one of the oldest buildings in Budapest with over 700 years of history and frescoes created by famous Hungarian painters. Continue on to **Fisherman's Bastion** for a view of the beautiful turrets, see the impressive **Heroes' Square** and the **Millennium Monument** located in its middle, and stroll along the fashionable shopping street, **Váci Utca**. Then, proceed to view **Buda Castle** is the historical castle and palace complex of the Hungarian kings in Budapest. In the past, it has been called Royal Palace and Royal Castle. The castle is a part of the Budapest World Heritage Site, which was declared a Heritage Site in 1987.
